Laughter Goes Viral at Cedarcroft



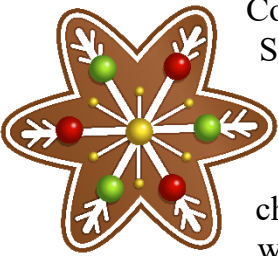

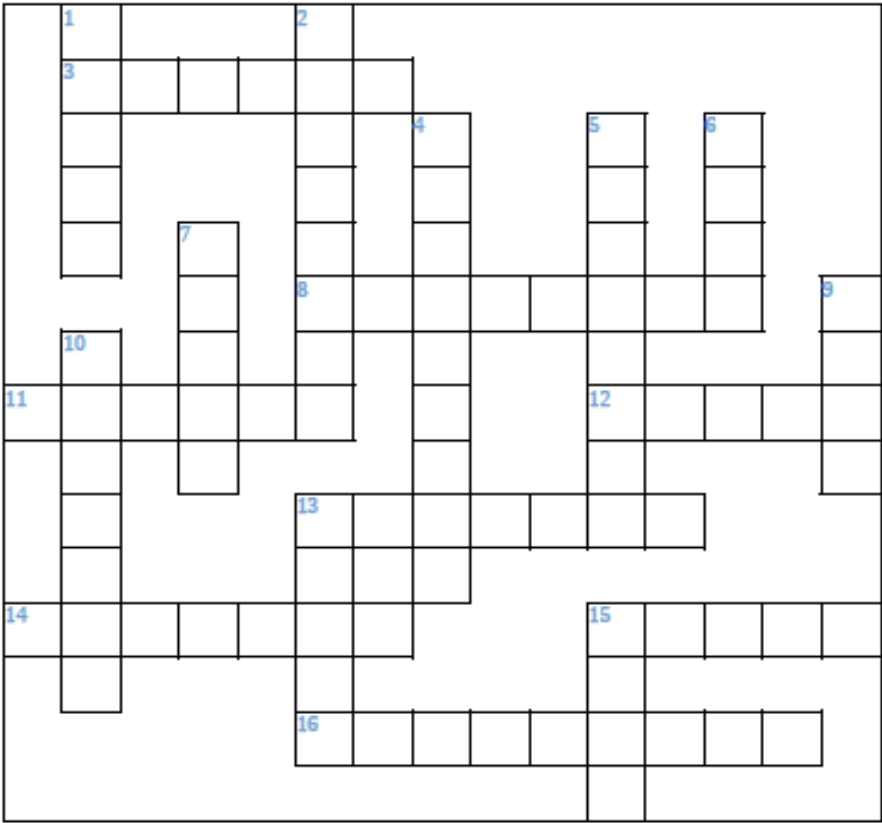

Feel The Beat!



Ball drumming is all the rage, and once you try it, it's easy to see why. People can't help but fall in love with the rhythm, movement, and pure fun it brings. Also known as "cardio drumming," the all-in-one activity blends music, motion, and mindfulness, boosting coordination, stimulating the brain, and lifting spirits with every beat.

At **Cataraqui Heights**, the program has been on the calendar for nearly two years, offered weekly in both Independent Living and BLOSSOM participants. But it wasn't an easy sell. As Nastasha Edwards, Director of Health & Wellness, explains, "Residents were definitely reluctant to join, but after we performed during a large social, it piqued their interest."

Curiosity turned into confidence, and soon residents were tapping, drumming, and laughing along together. Two years later, ball drumming is a favourite class at the Kingston, ON residence.

Not convinced? An instructor will guide you through a drumming routine that includes various cardio moves to get your heart rate up and your muscles engaged. The rhythmic tapping and upbeat patterns even help protect your brain from age-related changes. More importantly, it's a ton of fun!
